Dr. Bob Elliott was born June 7, 1933 in Roby, Texas to Berlin Francis and Opal (Robbins) Elliott, and died Wednesday, May 22, 2013 in a local hospital. Formerly of Baytown, he had resided in Lufkin since 2002.
