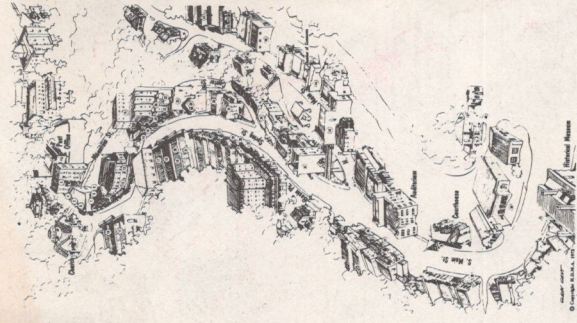




The History Of Eureka Springs

Nestled deep in the hillside, surrounded by lush forests, the historic district of Eureka Springs gives the modern visitor authentic glimpses of a city much like it was 90 years ago. The variety in design of the buildings that are garnished with wooden and stone filigree and surrounded by huge limestone retaining walls are ample evidence of the patient and tedious craftsmanship of the Victorian stylists.

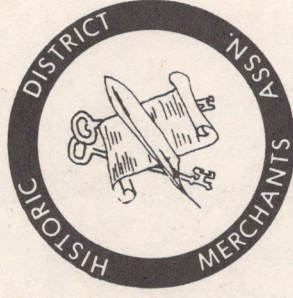
Discovered by Dr. Alvah Jackson in 1856, the city was officially entitled in 1879. The city mushroomed in size between 1880 and 1910 because of its greatest appeal—the seemingly endless supply of pure, clean water that HEALED.

Today Eureka Springs is a pleasure resort where visitors may explore the landmarks of a different age that are still in use. It offers a restful, slower-paced atmosphere and scenic views from practically every corner. Located in the downtown area are many strikingly individual shops that are well-suited to their structures providing a wide variety of excellent merchandise. Every shop maintains some of its original character, varying from the tin ceilings in some to the wood floors and fancy door facings in others. Also, most of the entrances to the businesses remain as they were first constructed.

Eureka Springs is a living legend because of its extensive preservation of buildings. It provides the visitor with a historical perspective in its intriguing layout and Victorian architecture. To complete the scope, the city is greatly enhanced by the canyons and ravines on all sides which are of breathtaking dimensions. All in all, the city is nostalgia and nature in a rare combination.
