Bro. Bill wants me to go to comman-
ment at Miranda tomorrow, then catch a
late bus to Cooper. I'd better, so the
people can see something of their
missionary. I'll not be worth
much Saturday or that test, but I'll
have to do my best. So, I'll
not see you till possibly Saturday
morning, before I go to take the
test. I'll get the bus schedule,
and you see if you can get someone
to meet me at the bus. If not,
I may have to wait till morning, take
the test, and then go out to the
school. Something will work out.
